## PAL Developing Mentor Program

Titusville PAL is developing a Mentoring Program. In collaboration with Eckerd Youth Alternatives and Urban City Connections PAL will offer stable and friendly connections for young participants. Positive, caring adults are matched with school-aged youth to give children one-on-one guidance and support in a community-based setting. Mentors will spend a minimum of one hour per week for at least a year with the youth and involve them in positive community activities.



Officer Gregory Shaw, PAL Executive Director stated “we believe that Mentoring can enhance a youngster's prospects for leading a healthy and productive life.” “We have been working hard to find the right program for the children we serve”.

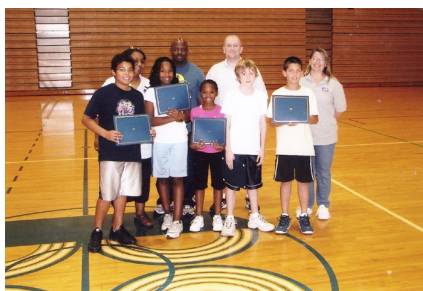
